

Protestation against Walkers & Listers 1695

Original held in Dundee City Archives along with the Weaver papers Ref: GD/TD/W/29/5

Att Edinburgh the seventeenth Day of Julie One Thousand Six hundred and Nyntie five yeares.

Thir being a Ratification Presented in Parliament to be past in favour of the Walkers and Listers of Dundie.

The following Protestation was offered and admitted against the same viz That it might not Prejudge the Right and Privilege of the Gildrie of Dundie wherof the saids Listers have ever been a member, Nor their Rights and Priviledges of the Nyne trades of the sd Burgh, And particularly ther rights and priviledges of the Bonnetmake trade ther, To Litt and Dye what onlie shall be necessary for their own Calling and Employment of Bonnetmaking.
