

Torpedoed

Two Caledon-built ships, the Blue Funnel liner Troilus , (7562 tons) and the Booth liner Origen (3545 tons) were torpedoed in the North Atlantic on their maiden voyages in 1917 and 1918 respectively.

The full-rigged ship Maju, of 900 tons, built by Brown & Simpson at Marine Parade in 1874, was wrecked with all hands near the Butt of Lewis a few days after leaving the Tay for Rangoon on her maiden voyage. The 24 victims included six ex-Mars training ship boys.
