## Torpedoed

Two Caledon-built ships, the Blue Funnel liner Troilus, (7562 tons) and the Booth liner Origen (3545 tons) were torpedoed in the North Atlantic on their maiden voyages in 1917 and 1918 respectively.

The full-rigged ship Maju, of 900 tons, built by Brown & Simpson at Marine Parade in 1874, was wrecked with all hands near the Butt of Lewis a few days after leaving the Tay for Rangoon

on her maiden voyage. The 24 victims included six ex-Mars training ship boys.
